

BOW HUNTER Camp

Arrival: Sunday, July 15 @ 6:30 PM (please make sure your child has had supper, before arrival)

Departure: Friday, July 20 @ 4:30 PM

**Camp Oasis will provide supper for your immediate family upon arrival and a short program highlighting your child's camp experience for the week. (Additional family members are \$4.00).*

Nebraska Game and Parks requires that participants be 11 years old.

Grades: For kids ENTERING FALL OF 2012 grades: 4th-7th.

Summer Theme: *the RUSH...* God is ALWAYS here for us! But, are we always here for HIM? We'll explore what it means to be a child of God, first and foremost in our lives.

Camp Description:

This camp is for kids that have an interest in bow hunting and would like to learn and improve their skills. In collaboration with Nebraska Game and Parks, we will offer the Bow Hunter Safety Course. (NOTE: if your child has already received their bow hunter certification, they will do additional activities while the others are in the classroom). We offer lots of range/practice time, blood trail training, tree stand safety, camouflage information, hunting with dogs and more. Your child will also experience all the fun things that Camp Oasis has to offer such as our amazing campfires, skits, hikes, swimming, crafts, canoeing, zip line, etc...

(*We swim off site and take our big yellow bus to get there).

What to Bring: Bible, flashlight, bug spray, water bottle, one piece swimsuit, bedding/sleeping bag and pillow, sun block, tennis shoes and flip flops, appropriate clothes for being outside, bath and swim towels and toiletries.

Important Information:

1. There is a \$40 deposit required at the time of registration. The deposit is not refundable.
2. The remaining balance is due June 1.
3. You can register for camp online, or download the forms and mail to Camp Oasis with your deposit.
4. You will receive a confirmation within 2 weeks of registering your child for camp.
5. Approximately 3 weeks prior to your child's camp: You will receive:
 - 1) health form and 2) a form indicating to whom your child may be released.All forms must then be completed and turned in to the camp office at least 1 week prior to the start of your child's camp.
6. Camp Store: Each day your child will visit our camp store which will have snacks, drinks and souvenirs. You can deposit money into your child's account when you send in their original

payment or when you arrive at camp. This year we have added many new items, such as water bottles, flashlights, hats, sling bags and more!

7. Any money remaining in the camp store will be donated to our scholarship fund. There are no store refunds.
8. We offer an "EXCLUSIVE T SHIRT" that is similar to the Cabin Leaders. The cost is \$15. They must be preordered by June 1.
9. If your child has any special needs, life events or behaviors that require additional attention or resources, be sure to inform the camp director at the time you initially register your child. We want to help your child have the best camp experience possible!
10. Camp Oasis provides an amazing opportunity for your child to gain independence and maturity in a safe, fun and exciting environment. Therefore, please let us determine if your child needs to call home. We love kids and we want them to be happy! We will keep their best interests in mind as we make that decision with them.
11. Please do not bring snacks, electronics, cell phones or anything that would distract from their camp experience.
12. Only Camp Oasis pets and animals are permitted on the premises.
